The City of Ljubljana would like to invite you to join us in the celebration of World Bee Day 2022. Key events are listed below. Several others will be published on our web page.

- **Guided tours of Ljubljana's Bee Path**, during the month of May there will be guided tours of the Bee Path every Tuesday and Saturday, starting from the 3rd of May.
- **Exhibition "Bee in Ljubljana"**, the exhibition in the Glass Atrium, City Hall, Ljubljana from the 12th till the 23rd of May where you can learn about the Bee Path in Ljubljana and the presentation of modules that Ljubljana is developing together with the transfer to 9 European cities. The exhibition is sponsored by the company A1, which is also a member of the Bee Path and will be enriched with the works of a street artist who is preparing a surprise for visitors of the exhibition between the 17th and 23rd of May 2022.
- **API Pedagogy Conference**, the 1st International Conference "API Pedagogy" organised by the Institute for the development of empathy and creativity Eneja will be held on the 18th of May 2022. The conference covers many areas, its main focus was pedagogy practice that includes
