Bilbao is the largest city in in the Basque Country with 346.000 inhabitants; 1.000.000 people in the Greater Bilbao, as the city-region is locally known. The Basque Country's financial capital, Bilbao has a thriving business ecosystem driving innovation and technological development in the region. Business sectors include startups and established businesses in ICT, Creative and Cultural Industries and Advanced Services.

Industry 4.0 policy focus & actions

- **Urban-regional collaboration** between public institutions and private companies.

- Pilot project where different levels of public institutions collaborate with KIBS companies and VET centers to identify gaps and needs of the talent ecosystem and co-construct solutions to address these challenges.
