How to get from Bucharest Airport to the city

- **TAXI:** Taking a taxi from Bucharest Airport to the city is quick and seamless, taking just 30 minutes in light traffic to reach the heart of the Old Town. There are two ways to catch a taxi, you can either head to the 'Fast Taxi' rank and get in the first available car, or you can book one using the touch-screen booking machine in the Arrivals Hall.
[Bucharest airport taxis](#) are always yellow and have their company logo on the side. Vehicles should be equipped with a working taximeter and depending on which booking option you use, you'll be able to choose between a 5 and 14-seater vehicle.
- **BUS:** There is only one bus line connecting Bucharest Airport to the city centre – the 100 Express line. The journey to Piata Unirii 2 (Union Square) Station takes between 40 to 60 minutes, with stops

at Roman Square and the university. This is the cheapest form of transport and the bus stops are conveniently located within walking distance from the Old Town.

- **TRAIN:** If you're not staying in the city centre or travelling to another destination in Romania, another affordable public transport option is the train. The train is operated by CFR Calatori and runs between Henri Coandă International Airport and Bucharest North (București Nord) station in 25 minutes. If you're staying in the Old Town, you'll have to change to a bus which can take over an hour. Trains run every 20 minutes except between 01:00 and 05:00 in the morning when they run about every 90 minutes.
