

Enable effective action learning with tailored expert support at local level and practical application of concrete methods and tools enabling innovation in public administrations.






URBACT Pioneers Accelerator targets...

Enthusiastic public service agents (teams) working in municipal departments/ agencies tackling specific urban challenges.

Around 20 cities 'Local Teams' shall be selected

Creating a generation of "Pioneering cities" (with urban professionals' leaders), who will be shaping the future of their cities in a new way, and be recognized as inspiration for their peers in the region.

...Get connected and learn from the URBACT and wider EU community (practitioners and experts) by utilising accumulated knowledge - mutual learning tools and methodologies


...gain inspiration and insights from first hand by visiting inspiring EU cities, exploring potential solutions and good practices

Finding the solution to a particular urban challenge!

Each applicant city (Local team) has the opportunity to work on a specific urban challenge by combining different thematic areas.

Primary topic:

Sustainable Tourism Development **Secondary topic:**

Sustainable Mobility

The city is interested in improving soft mobility for tourists, promoting walking tours, connecting public transport, and enhancing accessibility.

Expected results

> Implementation of small-scale pilot projects – visible quick-win on the ground, showcasing city's vision helping to attract future funding and partnerships.



ACT with On-the-ground Action


In each participating city, local teams will apply the 'learning by doing' approach and implement a concrete small-scale pilot projects – visible quick wins on the ground.



Key expected outputs

The Dynamic Journal (DJ)

All participating cities are expected to produce their respective DJs reflecting their learning experience and results. It serves as a reference for cities to document, revisit and build upon for future projects. It shall include:

- The portfolio of strategic planning tools being tried out
- Prioritised I deas and strategic Vision for the city
- Communication and Engagement Materials
- Illustration of concrete On-the-Ground Actions with implementation outcomes

The URBACT Pioneers Playbook

Key knowledge output produced at Programme level reflecting the outcomes of the URBACT Pioneers Accelerator learning journey.

• It shall be a practical "how to" guide for cities starting the process of designing and implementing sustainable transformation in urban environments.







The Budget and Reporting

The budget available for each selected city is 35 000 EUR. It shall ensure proper implementation of all expected Pioneers Accelerator learning activities. This includes the following estimations:

- <u>Around 15 000 EUR for the implementation of expected local activities</u> including the On-the Ground action (small-scale pilot project).
- Around 10 000 EUR for the internal staff costs salary (notably the URBACT Intern) supporting the local team with the project implementation over the entire duration of the programme.
- Around 10 000 EUR for travel and accommodation of the Local team participating at in-person events

[The available budget is co-financed 95% by IPA Funds. The remaining amount shall be financed by the local municipal budget]
[Up to 20% advance payments will be made possible for all participating cities on request]


+ The bespoke expertise support for the organisation of local activities by <u>URBACT Local Mentors – around 20 expertise days available for each city</u>.

This support will be managed and payed directly by the URBACT Joint Secretariat.

All participating cities will sign the subsidy contract with the URBACT Managing Authority. The reporting of all expenditures will be supported by the URBACT Joint Secretariat. Several reporting rounds are foreseen over the duration of the programme.







APPLICATION & SELECTION PROCEDURE





Who can participate?

The call is open to all 'cities' beneficiaries from IPA countries (Western Balkans):

- ✓ Cities, municipalities, towns,
- ✓ Infra-municipal tiers of government,
- ✓ Local agencies defined as public or semi-public organisations set up by a city,
- ✓ Metropolitan authorities and organised agglomerations



Cities already involved in ongoing URBACT networks <u>can apply</u> as well but only in cases where a different department (Local team) would be involved.

>> ADDED VALUE and SUFFICIENT CAPACITY SHALL BE DEMONSTRATED IF THE SAME PEOPLE ARE INVOLVED!

In the information about the Local team capacity to actively participate in the programme shall be provided in the application form. The appraisal of the capacity is part of the selection criteria.



The Pioneers Accelerator activities under the EMBRACE dimension - <u>notably the specific online Masterclass sessions will be open to all cities</u> from IPA countries already involved in ongoing URBACT networks regardless of their active participation in the Pioneers Accelerator.






The application process

All interested 'Cities' shall submit an online application form via the online EU survey platform.

! The Commitment Letter signed by the city's <u>elected representative</u> shall be attached to the application form.






Selection criteria

Application form questions and criteria for the selection of cities are designed to understand:

- Cities genuine need for this learning programme
- Motivation to implement concrete solution by applying the integrated and participatory approaches,
- Key capacity conditions for active involvement in foreseen activities,
- Having a clearly defined thematic focus representing the diversity of regional challenges and urgencies and urban contexts
- ✓ Demonstrating sufficient capacity having urban planning structures and technical expertise in place that will allow them to form Local Teams for effective knowledge uptake.
- √ Commitment to Integrated Planning and Peer-to-peer learning, openness to share
- √ Strong Stakeholder Engagement Understanding
- √ Willingness to Implement and Innovate test new ideas, approaches. Ability to apply learning
 within local projects/ policies



March 2025


- Applicants notified about the call results.

April 2025

- Welcome of all selected cities at URBACT City Festival in Wroclaw 8 10 April 2025
- Launch of the URBACT Pioneers Accelerator > Duration of the programme is 18 months.
- End of the programme is expected in September 2026.
