o. Intro

The report is briefly summarising all partners' and experts' activities to disseminate Ru:rban's transfer results to wider audiences.

1. Tips that were capitalised to disseminate the project results during the sharing period!

- Even the transfer target was very difficult, the idea to work on 3 different but strongly connected elements, made the Ru:rban transfer journey more interesting and finally successful
- The project has clearly met expectations and has been key to defining a long-term policy in urban gardens for all transferring cities
- The partners scored the transfer journey from 1 to 10 in terms of success, methodology tools, policy instrument improvement in the city level (urban gardening) and networking with peers from other cities The average result is: 8,5
- The LP managed also to improve its capacity of this urban policy tool, through its improvement plan
- The partnership adapted its methodology for the final transfer steps due to the pandemic, following a very coherent plan of online meetings, to prepare the partners FLLs, the project NRP and Transfer Story
- Each city's regulation for urban gardens management is delivered to all partners respective departments and then officially to their city councils

Ru:rban shared its' transfer stories experiences in urban gardens management in regional, national and international level. It shared that even the hardships that some partners faced, when you are working in a project team that can really support you, there are always solutions to be adopted and proceed to achieve the initial targets set.









2. Krakow - Poland

2.1 The National Urbact Point in Poland organized a session on the Urbact network during the Congress of Polish Cities held on 7-8.06.2021, which was organised exactly the same dates as the projects' 2nd TNM part in Krakow.

However, the Polish partner managed to take part in the meeting on the first day, during the Ru:rban Steering Committee session. Krakow representatives were connected with the National Event participants using the Zoom Platform, and the Polish ULG coordinator ULG shared a few words about the project results and presented the TNM session live!

During the second day of the Polish meeting, the ULG coordinator prepared a short presentation about the project, that was introduced by Aldo Vargas from the Polish National Point, that often participated in the partners' ULG meetings.









2.2 The Polish partner organised a very successful press conference during the 2nd day of the Ru:rban Krakow meeting (8/6/2021) with the city representatives.



3. Loures - Portugal

On March 4th,2021 Portugal URBACT National Contact Point held the Marathon of Transfers, a National Sharing Event that brought together the 17 Portuguese partners in an online event, in which experiences and results of their participation in URBACT Transfer Networks were shared among all and with the audience.

The marathon was an opportunity for the partners to present, at national and regional level, what they had learned in the work carried out with their European peers and to reach more cities with the example of the transfer of their good practices.

It was also the time to experience the successes and difficulties they had gone through and propose solutions. The event had around 300 entries, including technicians from the local administration, urban agents, researchers and members of the URBACT Local Groups (ULG) of the projects under consideration.







Loures representatives were there, disseminating the projects' results.



4. Caen - France

On June 3rd, 2021 the French URBACT National Contact Point held a closing Sharing Event that brought together all French partners in an online event, in which experiences and results of their participation in URBACT Transfer Networks were shared among all and with the audience. Another one similar style event will take place on September the 9th, 2021.

5. A Coruna – Spain

5.1 On May 14rd, 2021 the Spanish URBACT National Contact Point held also a closing Sharing Event that brought together all Spanish partners in an online event, in which experiences and results of their participation in URBACT Transfer Networks were shared among all and with the audience.









The Spanish NUP asked the Ru:rban coordinator Claudio Bordi, on behalf the city of Rome to present the projects highlights and results.











5.1 On June 30th, 2021 A Coruna city organised the Final Network Event online with the full support of the Network Expert for the preparation and organisation of the event. All details are included in the deliverables of the section 4.3 of the NE report.









6. Thessaloniki – Greece

The Community Enterprise of Thessaloniki, KEDITH, organised a very successful transnational online workshop on Thursday 6 May 2021, at 10.00-13.00 CET as part of the RU:RBAN 'Resilient Urban Agriculture and Landscape' project, implemented in the framework of URBACT III Programme.

The Workshop covered three main topics:

- Urban Community Gardens
- Urban Resilience
- Green Youth Initiatives









Given that the project reached its end, KEDITH organized this Workshop to share the good practices and experiences of the Ru:rban Transfer Network, aiming at transferring the project outcomes in other EU cities through its networks, exploring relevant initiatives and creating new synergies.



The NE Karamarkos Kostas also took part in the meeting and presented a special session titled: Why URBACT? Experiences from the RU: RBAN Transfer Network.











7. Urbact Festival 2021

All cities joined the Urbact Festival from 15-17 of June 2021 and LP representatives (Patricia Hernandez and Silvia Cioli) participated in the 1st Day special session about the Food Knowledge Hub.
