




Network Achievements (Strategy upgrades)

- The Eurometropolis of Strasbourg adopted a policy framework on the "One Health"
- Lyon updated the Health Strategy, incorporating the One Health approach



- Kuopio will use One Health as an umbrella concept for the city's strategy
- Munich integrated 2 One Health-relevant axes into the city's Health Guideline (health strategy)



Network Achievements (Testing & Scaling One Health)

- Benissa, Elefsina, Lahti, Suceava and Loule are continuing the implementation and scaling of One Health initiatives locally
 - Benissa on environmental protection and active ageing
 - Elfsina on organic gardens in schools and neighbourhoods
 - Lahti on environmental education and healthy diets
 - Suceava on climate change, and urban transformation projects
 - Loule on active healthy lifestyles and inclusiveness





Insights


- We are still in the beginning of the One Health implementation in cities
- From big urban cities to small rural towns, all have knowledge to share! All experiences are valuable.
- It takes time to make all stakeholders have a common understanding and a common vision of what One Health means.
- One Health can become a common goal across departments and make collaboration possible.





Insights

- We are already doing One Health we need to see the interlinkages of our work (biodiversity, urban planning, mobility, hygiene, etc.).
- We do not need to deliver One Health perfectly; we need to experiment, monitor, evaluate and improve.
- When you see through the One Health lenses, it is difficult to unseen it!


