

## 3RD CORE NETWORK MEETING IN CAMPOBASSO

## 1. 3RD CORE NETWORK MEETING IN CAMPOBASSO

### At Campobasso, looking into stakeholder collaboration in the metaverse

In early September, after a well-deserved summer break, it was time for all the METACITY partners to reunite and reactive joint activities at the Italian city of Campobasso, the capital city of the region of Molise.

This 3<sup>rd</sup> Core Network Meeting of our network was dedicated to the topic of Stakeholder Engagement and Collaboration, a key topic at a time where all network partners are planning or starting implementation of Testing Actions with local partners and accelerating the co-creation of actions for the future Integrated Action Plans with their urban communities.



The region of Molise and the City of Campobasso are partners in a large cooperative project that is gathering several players, from public, private and civic sectors, around the development of new emerging technologies, called the MoliseCTE where CTE stands for “House of Emerging Technologies” in Italian. In this meeting, all Metacity partners had the chance to visit the real “house”, the new head office of the project that hosts partners, startups and research activities in the outskirts of Campobasso and be presented with activities in the urban digital area from some of its main players – an example that can be an inspiration in terms of stakeholder collaboration for all partners.

## 1. 3RD CORE NETWORK MEETING IN CAMPOBASSO

The meeting also had the participation of an Ad-Hoc Expert, Simone d'Antonio, specialized in stakeholder engagement and that delivered a workshop on this topic and will continue to work with all partners to help them in the mobilization and engagement of local stakeholders for their activities and for the co-creation of the Integrated Action Plan, including in the organization of effective events.



But the meeting in Campobasso was also an opportunity for all partners to share progress on their activities, especially as regards ULG involvement and Testing Actions, and for the Lead Expert to provide individual feedback on the first draft Section 1 of the IAP delivered by partners in June. An energetic event for an energetic network, that is now ready to face the Winter months in working with local stakeholders in the development of digital activities for a more sustainable urban development – after all, it can always be summer in the Metaverse if we so wish!


## 2. HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE 2ND METACITY MASTERCLASS

**A Warm Welcome:** The day kicked off with a greeting from Razlog's Mayor, Krasimir Gerchev, who emphasized the exciting changes coming to education in the region. He set the tone for a day packed with innovation.



**Digital Lab Debut:** Todor Danyanov and Zlatka Stoycheva introduced Razlog's new Digital Lab, part of a broader initiative to experiment with cutting-edge technology in classrooms. It's all about preparing students for the future!
